



Puppy Vaccination Schedule

A new puppy is an exciting addition to your family. The puppy's health is both your and our responsibility. Following is a schedule of vaccinations and other services which we recommend:

6- 8 weeks Physical Examination

- Distemper/Parvovirus combination vaccine
- Internal Parasite Examination
- Deworming
- Begin Frontline or Advantage flea preventative *if needed*

9- 11 weeks Physical Examination

- Distemper/Parvovirus combination vaccine
- 1st Bordetella vaccine
- Giardia vaccine #1 (recommended)
- Deworming
- Frontline or Advantage flea preventative

12- 15 weeks Physical Examination

- Distemper/Parvovirus w/ Leptospirosis combination vaccine
- 2nd Bordetella vaccine
- Giardia vaccine #2 (recommended)
- Lyme Disease vaccine #1 (recommended)
- Start Heartworm Preventative

16- 18 weeks Physical Examination

- Distemper/Parvovirus w/ Leptospirosis combination vaccine
- Rabies vaccine
- Lyme Disease vaccine #2 (recommended)
- Continue Heartworm preventative

Then yearly - Complete Physical Examination, DHLPP, Giardia, Lyme Disease vaccines, Bordetella (Kennel Cough) according to risks

Rabies vaccination - 1st vaccination is good for 1 year, each subsequent vaccination can be good for 3 years

Intestinal Parasite and Blood Parasite Screening test yearly, with annual exam and vaccinations

Spay or Neuter at approximately 3-6 months of age.

Strategic Deworming every 3 months as needed according to risk (see our handout on Deworming Protocols)
